Having conveyed to my Son Hanyost & John Lot N^o. thirty one in the last ment^d. tract at Springfield I shall therefore remain silent respecting them, only to my Son John I give & bequeath my Negro Man Slave named Nicholas. -

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elisabeth the Wife of Ananias Nellis the Sum of five hundred and sixty two Dollars & fifty Cents lawful Money of the United States; And to my Daughter Margareth the Wife of Henry Block, I give & bequeath the like Sum of five hundred and sixty two Dollars & fifty Cents of like lawful Money as afores^d. in lieu of a certain Lot of Land of two hundred Acres at Springfield in the last ment^d. tract known by the Name of Lot N^o. thirty six. -

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Daughters Anna the Wife of Casper Leib and Maria the Wife of William W. Nellis & to their Heirs and Assigns for ever a certain Lot of Land situate at Springfield in the last ment^d. Tract known by the name of Lot N^o. twenty three containing two hundred Acres, to be equally divided between Share & Share alike. -

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Daughters Catharine the Wife of William Sattzman & Magdalene the Wife of William J. Nellis and to their Heirs & Assigns for ever a certain Lot of Land situate also at Springfield in the Tract last ment^d. known by the Name of Lot N^o. fourteen containing two hundred Acres, to be equally divided between them Share & share alike. -

Item I also give devise & bequeath unto my six Daughters before named & to their Heirs & Assigns for ever, a certain Lot of Land situate at a place called the little Lake, also in the last ment^d. tract, known by the name of Lot N^o. five containing four hundred Acres, to be divided between them in the following manner & form viz^t. to my Daughters Elisabeth the Wife of Ananias Nellis & Margareth the Wife of Henry
