


Henry Block each fifty Acres and to my Daughters Anna the Wife of Casper Leib, Maria the Wife of William W. Nellis Catharine the Wife of William Sattman & Magdalene the Wife of William J. Nellis, each Seventy five Acres. - I further give & bequeath to each of them the Sum of two hundred & fifty Dollars lawful Money as afores^d. to be paid by my Son Peter out of the outstanding Debts due me & by him to be collected, and what ready Money there may be on hand at my decease as afores^d. the Gold bequeathed to my Wife excepted, which is not to be considered as a part of the ready Money last ment^d. -

N.B. The two Cows & two Sheep which my Son Peter is to keep for my said Wife are to be taken from my Stock that shall be left at my decease & after my Wifes decease the said Cows & Sheep are to become the property of my Son Peter the residue of my Stock of Horses, - neat Cattle & Sheep and whatever personal property else that shall be left at my decease & which is not particularly bequeathed by me I will shall be equally divided between all my Sons & Daughters Share & Share alike. -

Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my true & trusty Friends Peter Grembs Jun^r. Richard Young & my Son Peter to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament; and I do hereby utterly disallow, disannul & revoke all and every other & former Wills, Testaments, Legacies, bequests and Executors by me in any wise heretofore named, willed and bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will and Testament. -

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & six. - Peter Waggoner 

Signed sealed published pronounced and declared by him the said Peter Waggoner as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence & in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our Names as Witnesses. Note, the different interlinations & obliterations were duly done & performed before the execution hereof.
