I Peter Waggoner of the town of Palatine in the County of Montgomery & State of New York do this eighth Day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nine make and publish this Codicil to my last Will & Testament bearing date the fifth Day of April one thousand eight hundred & six in manner following (that is to say) whereas in & by my said last Will & Testament I have given & bequeathed unto my beloved Wife Barbara during her natural life yearly the Sum of Seventy five Dollars Lawfull Money of the United States, to be paid by my Son Peter Waggoner Jun^r. &c. (as is therein specified) exclusive of a decent & competent maintenance, some Gold Coin contained in a square Box & leather pouch, together with other Matters & Articles too tedious to enumerate; Now I do hereby order & declare that my will is that the said Sum of Seventy five Dollars yearly shall not be paid her if not necessary for her maintenance & special service, and that the said Money shall not be demanded of my said Son Peter after her decease. And whereas in & by my said last Will & Testament, I have given devised & bequeathed unto my Daughters Elisabeth the Wife of Andrew Nellis & Margareth the Wife of Henry Block & to their Heirs for ever, each fifty Acres of Land situated at Springfield in the County of Otsego at a place called the little Lake out of Lot N^o five in Waggoners Tract, Now I do hereby order & declare that my will is that the Sum of fifty Dollars Lawfull Money of the United States shall be paid to each of them or their Heirs in lieu of the said Lands by my Grandsons William P. Waggoner & Peter G. Waggoner on the following terms (to wit) the Sum of sixteen Dollars to each at the expiration of one year from the date of my decease the Sum of sixteen Dollars to each at the expiration of two years after my decease & the further Sum of eighteen Dollars to each at the expiration of three years after my decease; And that I give
